### 2002 VINTAGE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

84% Schram Vineyard, 16% McEachran Vineyard  
97% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Malbec  
Average yields: 2 tons per acre  
100% Napa Valley Certification Mark  
Oak barrel aging: 19 months  
    50% new oak, 50% single-vintage barrels  
Bottle aging: 9 months  
Release date: April 2, 2005  
Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered

### Tasting notes:

“Rich, dense berry fruit jumps out of the glass. Reminiscent of blackberry, boysenberry and black cherry, these delicious fruitful aromas are lifted by hints of anise and clove - the sweet spice characteristic of ripe Diamond Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon. The intense juicy flavors that follow are balanced with resolved tannins and light touches of vanillin and toasted oak. Unfiltered and unfiltered, its palate is smooth, velvety, and complete.”
